Augustine was also an active member at The Grasonville Senior Center, where she liked to play Bingo, put puzzles together (the big pieces) and dancing "shaking a tail feather". Augustine loved to have family and friends come to visit, especially Alicia and Darryl, from North Carolina and she really loved having her great-great-great twin nieces, Aleyah & Aubrey, over. She would watch them play all day. She called them her babies and said they were born just for her. Augustine was such a bright light and when she laughed, it was one of a kind. You would never forget her once you met her.

In addition to her mother, Augustine was preceded in death by her sister, Nancy Robinson; nephews, Mercer and Stanley Turner; and great niece, Zakiyah Turner.
