Rev. Accola Horsey was born on March 16, 1940 in Allen, Maryland. She departed this life to be with her Lord and Savior on August 18, 2014 at the Delaware Hospice Center in Milford, Delaware at the age of 74. Her father, James Rollo Jones, Sr., her mother, Gladys Elizabeth Jones and her sister, Ella May Nichols preceded her in death.

Accola or “Cola” as many of her friends and family called her, graduated from Salisbury High School in 1958.
