Berius Joseph Delva, aged sixty-nine (69), a resident of Salisbury, Maryland, passed away peacefully on August 17, 2024, surrounded by his loved ones. In Haiti, he was a farmer and started a business in which he purchased large quantities of cotton and resold it to major companies such as Idai.

In August of 1980, he migrated to Miami, Florida, leaving his family behind in Haiti. After two years, he moved to Salisbury, Maryland, where he quickly became known to his new friends as "95." This nickname, reflecting his vibrant spirit, originated from a memorable incident when he got lost on I-95 during his drive from Florida to Maryland.

Berius became a U.S. citizen on November 7, 2008, a milestone he proudly celebrated. Throughout his life, he was always an upstanding man who respected the law and strong moral principles.

He was joyfully married to his beloved wife, Saintania Delva, for thirty-five, years, sharing a total of fifty-one, wonderful years together. He was a devoted husband and a loving father to their two children, Bertha Charles (Renel) and

Arise Delva. He was also a proud father to Betty Delva, Elicier Delva, and Ralph Delva (Sherlie), all of whom he cherished deeply. As a grandfather to sixteen (16) grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren, Berius found his greatest joy in his family.
