Bertina Viola Jackson was born in Dames Quarter, Maryland to the late Carrie (Wigfall) White and Ralph A. White, Sr. on February 21, 1940. At the age of eighty (80), Bertina departed this life on Friday, February 5, 2021 at Tidal Health Peninsula Regional Hospital in Salisbury, Maryland.
