Bettie S. Turner of Denton, MD departed this life on September 26, 2012 at the Caroline Nursing Home, Denton, MD. She was 94 years old.

Born December 26, 1917 in Yazoo City, Mississippi to Eddie Seymour and Estelle Harris, she was one of nine siblings, having four brothers and four sisters. She spent her childhood and attended school in Yazoo City, MS before moving to Maryland with her late husband, Timothy Turner to help him on the farm. She also did factory work.

Bettie Turner was a devoted member of the Harmony Missionary Baptist Church in Denton since the founding of the church in 1945 under the leadership of her father-in-law, the late Rev. D.R. Turner, then pastor. She served faithfully as a Deaconess, Mother of the Church, Sunday School teacher, Sunday School secretary and member of the choir. She also sang with the N.T.S. Singers. She was often recognized for delivering dramatic recitations and for being the greeter/official extender of the welcome address for the church. At points in her life, she served as a member of the National Quartet Association, the Gospel Rama Association, the Eastern Shore Gospel Association and the Progressive Baptist Association of the Eastern Shore, Inc.

In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by her husband of 70 years, Timothy Turner; her daughter, Mary Lovely and her four brothers and

four sisters.

She leaves to mourn her memory a son, Robert Turner (Clara) of Federalsburg; daughter, Martha Dickerson of Federalsburg; son-in-law, Arthur Lovely of Baltimore; sister-in-law, Mrs. Chocolate Wright of Wilmington, DE; 11 grandchildren, 15 great grandchildren, a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
