Betty Moore was born on September 17, 1951 with her late twin brother, Billy, in Salisbury, Maryland to the late James Price, Jr. and Katherine Wright Price. Surrounded by her loving family, God sent an angel to usher her home on Wednesday, December 30, 2015, at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury, Maryland after a courageous battle with lung cancer.

Betty received her formal education in the Wicomico County Public School System and graduated from James M. Bennett High School in 1969. She furthered her education by attending Strayer University College.

She started her professional career as an employee for the U.S. State Department in Washington, DC. She later moved back to Salisbury where she was employed by WBOC 16, WMDT 47 and Dresser Wayne until the company closed. Her last employment was with Home Depot until she was diagnosed with lung cancer in 2009.

On May 7, 2000, Betty was united in holy matrimony to Roland Lee Moore. To this union, a son, Sean, was born, whom she loved very dearly.

At an early age, Betty accepted Christ as her Savior and joined First Baptist Church in Salisbury under the pastorate of the late Rev. Judson Chappelle Mills and used her talent singing with Temple Choir. She also would attend

church services at New Hope Baptist Church and Community Christian Church which are located in Salisbury.

Betty was a beautiful person with a loving personality and humble spirit that attracted many people to her life. She loved her family and would display her affection with hugs and kisses.
