Carl Savage Young Sr., at the age of eighty-eight (88), went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, June 26, 2022. Born on April 13, 1934, he was the eldest son of the late Abel and Sarah Jane Adkins Young of Newark, MD.

He was educated in the Worcester County public school system and after graduation, enlisted in the United States Army, where he served as a Medical Corpsmen for 6½ years. Following his discharge, he returned home and worked at Peninsula General Hospital and later Deer's Head State Hospital, both in Salisbury, MD for the next 25 years until retirement. Following retirement, he began to work for the Wicomico County Regional Library, delivering books to all the libraries on the upper Eastern Shore. His delightful personality made him an ideal fit for all the faces, places and spaces he encountered. After 22 years, Carl retired from the library to enjoy a life of leisure with family and friends. His favorite pastimes were tinkering in his shed, watching old westerns and spending time with his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Carl was a faithful member of Powerhouse Church of God in Christ in Salisbury, MD for over 25 years, serving as a Deacon under the leadership of Elder Alexander Duffy, Sr. He was a dedicated and pleasant member who would lend a hand whenever called upon.
