The early life of Carlton Miller Brown began on Tuesday, October 27, 1925 in San Domingo, MD and ended on Monday, September 1, 2015 at 2:30 a.m. at Genesis Healthcare Center in Salisbury, MD at the age of 89 years, 11 months, and 4 days.

Carlton was the son of the late Hargus Miller and Ida E. Horsey Brown.

Carlton received his education in the Wicomico County Schools and graduated from Salisbury High School. After graduation he enlisted in the U.S. Navy where he was a cook.

After being Honorable discharged from the service he began his career with the DuPont Company, he retired in 1983.

ON December 31, 1954 he was united in holy matrimony to the late Helena Travers, who passed on April 12, 1969. To this union were born five children- Naymon, Damon, Bobbi, Ethal, and Carlton. Carlton kept the family together until they were all grown.

He joined and served faithfully at Mt. Calvary AME Church under the pastorage of the late Rev. A Norman Clark. He was the Pastor's Steward, a member of the Men's Choir and a member of the Building Fund Committee. He was a dedicated and loyal servant until his health declined.

Carlton was a member of Sharptown- Columbia American Legion post No. 269 for 62 years.
