She was born to Gladys Crawford de Beckford and Alfred Soley, on September 6, 1964, in Panama City, Republic of Panama. Caroline graduated from Cristobal High School in 1982, received a bachelor's, a Master's, and a Doctorate in Business Management. She joined the United States Air Force in February 1983 and retired as a Master Sergeant in August 2006. Caroline became an ordained Minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, October 2012, with Christian Ambassadors Worship Center International. She loved writing poetry and she loved our LORD and Savior, Jesus Christ first, with all her heart and demonstrated that love by loving all His creation. In addition, she was a published author, wrote and dedicated 10 books to Jesus Christ about being more like Christ; five in English and five in Spanish.
