Cassie Lee Thompson, daughter of the late Jeff and Vassie Robinson was born on July 1, 1917 in Dothan, Alabama. She entered her eternal

rest on Thursday, July 25, 2013 at Bayhealth-Milford Memorial Hospital, Milford, DE.

Mother Cassie received her early education in the public schools in

Dothan, AL.

Mother Cassie met and married Isaac Thompson on September 29, 1933 in Ft. Gaines, GA. Nine children were part of this fruitful and faithful

relationship. In 1941, they moved to Delaware. Mother Cassie was a life

member of Mt. Sinai Tabernacle, under the pastorate of the late 'Elder

Ancle Mann (1942-1969), then under the late Elder John Nichols (1969-

1984), and now under the leadership of Elder Elmer Bratten (1984 to present).

Mother Cassie loved her church and continued to attend until she was no

longer able.

It was between the ages of 8 and 9 that she gave her life to the Lord

during a revival in Alabama. She would often testify in relations to

Trappe Kingdom Church of God at Fort Gaines, GA. Mother and

Deacon Thompson served under Elder Howard as a young couple. When she moved to Delaware her fellowship was with Mt. Zion Holy Church, Milton, Delaware under the late Elder Jacob Brittingham, Sr. She was a part of the church clean up committee, church treasurer, Pastor's Aide president, communion steward, worship leader, also worked on the anniversary and women's day committee. She was a licensed minister of Mt. Sinai Holy Church of America, Inc.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Isaac Thompson in 1998 and three sons-in-law, Anthony Pettyjohn, John McDaniel and Joshua Brittingham, Sr.
