Mrs. Catherine Huell Carey was the fourth of seven children, born to the late Freddie Huell and the late Lillie Grannison Huell on May 31, 1942, in the Blakely community of Salters, South Carolina. She departed this life on Wednesday, May 28, 2014, caused by the effects of Alzheimer's disease. She was 71.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by a brother, Mr. Freddie L. Huell and a nephew reared as a brother, Mr. Jackie L. Huell. Catherine accepted Christ at an early age and joined Jerusalem A.M.E Church in Salters, South Carolina where she sang on the junior choir. Throughout Catherine's Christian experience she was a member of several other churches including M.F. one grandson Terrell Carey-Jackson. Catherine was a retired federal government employee for the United States Department of Agriculture, providing them with 30 plus years of dedicated service. Catherine spent her free time with friends and family, and vacationing with her husband in the Caribbean, Hawaii, and Spain.
