Cecil Irvin Jones was born on Thursday, May 25, 1950, to the late Daniel Ervin Jones and Hettie Ann Riley Jones in Weems, Virginia. After a lengthy illness, Cecil, age 68, of Lewes, Delaware, departed this life on Saturday, February 9, 2019, at his home.
