The Life and Legacy of Charles Stanley Collins

Charles Stanley Collins was born September 17, 1958, in Salisbury, Maryland to Hattie Josephine Brown and the late Charles Collins. He departed this life on Saturday, May 14, 2022, at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, Maryland.

Charles, also known to family and friends as Timmy, and affectionately called Pop-Pop by his grandchildren, was educated in the public schools of Worcester County. He attended Church Street School in Stockton, Maryland and upon their closure, transferred to Pocomoke Middle and Pocomoke High School, from where he would graduate. In 1976, Charles enlisted into the United States Marine Corps, where he served his country until 1979. Once he returned to the Eastern Shore, he worked at the Worcester County Jail until he retired in 2006. It was at this time he would meet the love of his life, Baby Cake.

On February 28, 1987, Charles was united in holy matrimony to Chiffon Nina Satchell. He was a devoted husband and you very seldom saw Charles without Chiffon.

During retirement, Charles worked as a substitute bus driver for Worcester

County public schools. In addition to helping his wife decorate and maintain the home, he enjoyed doing word search puzzles and watching television. His favorite shows included Joe Kendra and Diners, Drive-Ins, and Dives. After hearing his father-in-law's (Solomon, 2011) choir sing "Farther Along", this became his special song. However, his favorite pastime was spending time with his grandson, Jalèn Planter. He cherished the moments he got to take Jalèn to work and "hangout" with him. Charles was a very caring Big Brother, father, and son, making daily phone calls to check on family, especially his mother whom he would call twice a day. While Charles loved and was fond of all his nieces and nephews, he had a special bond with Tiara Collins, with whom he shared a birthday date.

Left behind to cherish precious memories are: his loving wife, Chiffon Collins of Berlin, Maryland; two daughters, Shantae "Peaches" (Calvin) Jones of Snow Hill, Maryland and Lashekia Beckett of Berlin, Maryland and a son, Ronsha Satchell of Salisbury, Maryland; his mother, Hattie Collins of Pocomoke City, Maryland; mother-in-law, Queen (Robert) Satchell-Leonard; six brothers, Stanford (Ludamila) Collins of Baltimore, Maryland, Brian (Teresa) Collins of Prince George, Virginia, Ronnie (Wanda) White of Pocomoke City, Maryland, Wendell White of Pocomoke City, Maryland, Timothy (Sheryle) Townsend of McDonough, Georgia and Warren (Connie) Peyton of Federal Way, Washington; two sisters, Genise Fleming of Salisbury, Maryland and Paula Collins of Prince George, Virginia; three brothers-in-laws, Fontaine Bowen, Kaleel Satchell and Earlest (Patsy) Satchell, all of Berlin, Maryland.

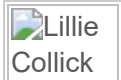
