Christopher attended the Upward Bound Program and graduated from Milford Senior High School, Class of 2002 where he began to show many of his talents. He was in the Milford Marching Band, which he was the 2nd Black Drum Major in the history of Milford High, Jazz Band, Concert Band, DECA, Drama Club, Dance Team, and Track Team as a long distance runner.
