Clint St. Louis was born on December 7, 2000 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury, Maryland.

He was the only child between Moret St. Louis of Petite Goâve, Haiti and Sameina Ennels of Maryland, United States.

Clint is survived by his parents, Moret and Sameina as well as four brothers, Norman Owens, Maliek Owens, Noah St. Louis and Nahum St. Louis. He is also survived by his Grandfather, his aunts Bonita Washington, Sylviana Moridon and his uncles Edward Ennels, Keylose Washington, Steven Washington, Timothée St. Ruis and Excellent St. Rius, while also having multiple uncles residing in Haiti. Two years ago, on October 25, 2018 Clint was involved in an accident which resulted in a traumatic brain injury. In his final months, Clint was in the loving care of his mother where he soldiered on as strong, and for as long as he could until his untimely death
