The Life and Legacy of Curtis Lee Milbourne, Sr.

Curtis Lee Milbourne, Sr. peacefully passed away on Friday, July 1, 2022 at 12:24 am under the love and attentive care of the staff at Coastal Hospice by the Lake in Salisbury, Maryland. He was born on Saturday, January 22, 1949.

Educated in the public schools of Worcester County, Maryland, Curtis graduated from Worcester High School in Newark, Maryland with the class of 1968.

After being drafted into the United States Army in 1969, Curtis served a tour of duty in both the Vietnam War and Iraqi Freedom (Kuwait). He was honorably discharged after thirty-nine (39) years of service on November 12, 2007 from the United States Air Force (Dover Air Force Base) in Dover, Delaware. Immediately following his military service, Curtis went on to work for the Easton Distribution Center, from where he too retired.

Some of his accolades include graduating from the Criminal Justice Academy at Wor-Wic Tech, along with holding many positions of prestige consisting of Commander of the VFW Post 10048, Commander of the American Legion,

and Worshipful Master of the Unionville Lodge No. 45.

Curtis began his life with Christ at Cool Springs United Methodist Church in Girdletree, Maryland. He later moved his membership to New Macedonia Baptist Church in Pocomoke City, Maryland.

Curtis leaves to cherish unforgettable and precious memories with his beloved, devoted wife of thirty-five (35) years, Marlene Elizabeth Milbourne of Pocomoke City, Maryland; four children, Curtis Lee Milbourne, Jr. (Anita), Mary Chanyn Farmer, Natasha Shant'a Milbourne and Kyra Lorene Milbourne; four grandchildren; three brothers, Wilbert Milbourne, Jr. of Berlin Maryland, Rex Milbourne of Girdletree, Maryland and Gil Milbourne of Pittsville, Maryland and a host of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and in-laws.
