Dallas McKinley Adams was born on April 30, 1945, in Baltimore, Maryland. He was the fourth child born to the late Melvin and Janie Adams. He attended Maces Lane High School, graduating on June 3, 1963, and later continued his education at Morgan State University on a music scholarship, where he was a talented trumpet player. He went on to receive his associate's degree from Delaware Technical and Community College on May 15, 2012, earning many accolades, including membership in Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society and Alpha Beta Gamma. Dallas was a dedicated worker throughout his life. He worked at DuPont and retired from there, but his strong work ethic led him to continue even after retirement. He went on to work at Kent Sussex Industries (KSI), a job he truly loved because it kept him busy, often saying, 'I will work until the day I die.'

On January 16, 1970, in Preston, Maryland, Dallas was united in holy matrimony to Albertha Wiggins, and together they built a life filled with love, laughter, and family, joyfully celebrating 56 years of marriage before his passing. He was a devoted family man who loved his family deeply; family was everything to him. A true provider with a kind heart, Dallas was a "jack of all trades and master of none," as he would always say. Known as a great storyteller and playful prankster, he could light up any room with his humor and vivid memories. His quick wit, warm
