Dallas R. Johnson was born to Robert Dallas Johnson and Blanche Holmes Hamilton (John Hamilton) on Wednesday, December 14, 1921 in Ridgely, Maryland. He departed this life at the age of 94, on Thursday, January 14, 2016 at his son, Lamonte's home in Seaford, Delaware.

He attended schools in Ridgely and enlisted into the United States Army in 1941. He served in the South Pacific and was honorably discharged in 1945. Dallas was employed for over 60 years as a truck driver in Maryland and Delaware, retiring in 2013 at the ripe age of 92.

Dallas married Florence Emma Young in 1942 and to the union were born two sons, Dallas Junior Johnson and Robert Ernest Leroy Johnson.
