David Benjermine Ballard, Jr., affectionately known as “Benny”, transitioned from his earthly life to his eternal reward on Saturday, April 13, 2024 at the age of seventy-three (73). Surrounded by his loving family, he passed at Tidal Health Peninsula Regional Hospital in Salisbury, Maryland. David was the son of the late David B. Ballard, Sr. and Anna D. 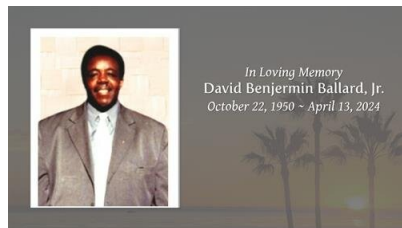
