On Thursday, August 26, 1965, Lillie Marshall Collick and the late James Edward Collick, Sr. were blessed with a baby girl, DeCheryl Edette Collick. God dispatched an angel for her peaceful transition from earth to eternal glory on Tuesday, July 27, 2021.

DeCheryl received her formal education in Worcester County, Maryland and East St. Louis, Illinois. She graduated from Pocomoke High School in Pocomoke City, Maryland in 1983. Although she applied to and was accepted at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) in Princess Anne, Maryland, she opted to attend Delmarva Beauty Academy in Salisbury, Maryland instead. She loved doing hair, especially at the beginning of a new school year. She was employed at a Jamesway in Wilmington, Delaware and Amazon. DeCheryl was also employed by Roses and Kmart in retail until her health began to fail.

Initially DeCheryl was a member of St. Paul United Methodist Church in Stockton, Maryland. Later, the family transferred membership to Shiloh United Methodist Church in Pocomoke, Maryland. She always said, "Whatever we

did on Saturday night, Mom was going to make us go to church on Sunday mornings.” On July 25, 2021, she asked for Reverend Helen Lockwood. Our cousin, the Reverend Shirley Wallop Chase went to John Hopkins Hospital and prayed with her. Shortly afterwards, the transitioning process began. She said she was ready to go.

Family was very important to “Cheryl” as she lovingly and affectionately known to many. She loved hanging with her sister, cousins and friends. To know her was to love her and her comical wit.
