Delores' Journey

Delores (Aunt Sis) Jones age 84, transitioned into her eternal rest on Thursday, August 15, 2024 at home surrounded by her loving family. Sister, as she was often called by her family, was the oldest daughter of the late Marshall and Eunice Jones.

Sister graduated from Mace's Lane High School Class of 1958 and later graduated from the University of Maryland Eastern Shore College. Sister lived in Baltimore, Easton, and New York for several years. She returned home to be closer to her parents and siblings.

Sister made a career at Easton Memorial Hospital as a registered dietician for over 33 years until her retirement in 2003. She was also a caterer and was known for her punch bowl cakes, punch, applesauce cakes and famous for her chicken and dumplings. Sister was very active after she retired; taking care of her uncles James, Buddy and aunt Lucinda. Sister took care of her mother, Lena and also helped take care of her sister, Parthenia. She would also take different people in the community to run errands as well.

Sister was an active member of the former New Revelations Baptist Church where she served as the Usher Board President and the Kitchen Committee

President. She would travel the Eastern Shore every Sunday to attend Usher's Days. Her sisters and cousin, Timmy Hayes and riding partner, Annie Askins would often accompany her. Sister was a faithful member and servant.

Although Sister never married and never had any biological children, she was the mother of the family and helped raise her nieces, nephews and her grand nieces and nephews as well. Sister was a proud Mom-Mom to Jada Adams. She was the go-to person for the family and could often be found sitting on her porch everyday with her sisters Parthenia and JoAnne. Her house was the gathering place for many family dinners and she would always have something good to eat on Sundays.

Sister leaves to mourn: two brothers, Clifton (Shirley) Jones of Delmar, MD and Edward Jones of Blades, DE and one sister, JoAnne Dickerson of Cambridge, MD; one brother-in-law, Hansel Greene of Cambridge, MD; a special niece, Kisha and grand nephew DaiBreon Jones who were her primary caretakers; an aunt, Lucinda Jones of Cambridge, MD; an uncle, Arthur Jones; two special cousins, Nona Tillery and Timmy Hayes; god children, Keonia (Niece), Mikey, Nicholas, Jessica, Jabria (Niece); special family friends, Carlton Stanley, Delilah Watson and Carlton Jackson as well as a host of other relatives, church family and friends.

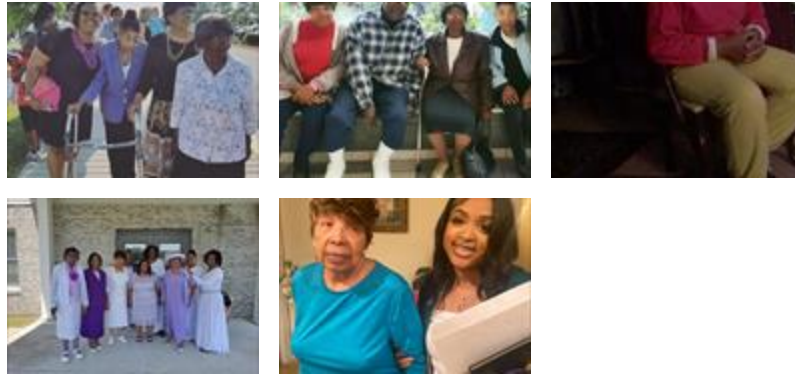
