Donald Q. Fisher Jr., son of the late Donald Q. Fisher, Sr., and Willow Mae Fisher, was born on Saturday, April 8, 1961, in Wilmington, Delaware. He departed this life on Tuesday, October 15, 2019, while under the awesome care of Seasons Hospice & Pallative Care at Christiana Hospital.

Dad and Mom kept us in line once we left the house. People couldn't believe how well mannered we were. But if only they knew how we were when we got back home. We were like little Tasmanian devils among each other, but no one could come between us. As kids we loved betting on football games with our little nickels, dimes and quarters. We thought we were like the Jackson 5; Demetrius played the

Drums, Donnie played the trumpet, Danny played the guitar and thought he was Michael Jackson as the lead singer, Darrell played the guitar, and Donnell tried to play the organ and thought he was Jermaine Jackson.

Donnie was preceded in death by his father, Donald Q. Fisher Sr.; his mother, Willow Mae Fisher; and his brothers, Demetrui C. Fisher and Darrell L. Fisher.
