She was an employed at the Nanticoke Seafood Company as a Union Steward until she retired. All her life, she was helpful to her family and friends. She fed the hungry, clothed the naked and provided shelter to the homeless. She also provided transportation if needed.

Dorothy lived her life to the fullest. She held every position in the church from the door to the pulpit. She had concerns for the safety of the seniors, so the neighborhood watch was started under her leadership (receiving phone calls every morning to check on them). Additionally, she was a member of Chapter 4 Lodge in Nanticoke, Maryland, Bivalve Women's Auxillary and at Deer's Head Center, she volunteered and then became Chaplain. These are just a few of her accolades and involvements.

Dorothy's hobbies were singing, gardening, fishing, attending Baltimore Oriole baseball games, cooking (especially sweet potato pies) and she loved clothes. She would often say, "Clothes made the woman."
