Douglas graduated from William C. Jason Comprehensive High School in Georgetown, Delaware, and attended Delaware State College (now University). In November 1964, Douglas was drafted into the United States Army where he served in the Vietnam War and received an Honorable Discharge in January 1970. After he served his country, Doug was employed with E.I. DuPont de Nemours & Company, Inc. of Seaford, Delaware for 32 years before retiring.

During his earlier years in life, Doug played the piano and organ for John Wesley United Methodist Church in Seaford, DE. He received his training from his mother.
