Youth Pastor, Elder Edna Charlotte Wright, at the age of sixty-seven (67), departed this life into the arms of Jesus on Tuesday, April 24, 2021 with her daughters, grandson, sisters and extended family by her side at home in Fruitland, Maryland. She was born on August 29, 1953 to the late John Edward and Marybell Polk. She fondly was nicknamed "Lottie" by her family and those who were close to her.

Edna attended Wicomico County public schools and graduated from Bennett High School in Salisbury, Maryland. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Education and Teaching from the University of Maryland Eastern Shore. She was employed by the Worcester County Board of Education from 1978 until her retirement in 2020. Edna was recognized as the school 2004 Teacher of the Year and she was also the recipient of the Life Changer of the Year Award in 2019, as well as many other nominations and professional accolades. She was a passionate classroom teacher for forty-two (42) years with a loving touch for each student. Her Family Consumer Science Class was a favorite for the many generations of students who walked the halls of Pocomoke Middle School. Her legacy was felt by the thousands of students she connected with and mentored, even after their graduation. Edna was

more than a teacher; she gave her students love and self-worth. Every student has a Mrs. Wright story and a great tasting recipe.

Edna has been the Elder and Youth Pastor at Miracle Deliverance Tabernacle (MDT) for over twenty (20) years. She was loved and revered by the youth of MDT. They often would call her “Elder Mom-Mom.” The tri-county area has witnessed many selfless acts which reflected her devotion and commitment to the ministry of which GOD put in her charge. She was a consistent blessing and asset to the ministry and the surrounding communities. Her unwavering dedication in service to others revealed the strength of her character time and time again. Her personal interactions showed true evidence of life-changing love at work in and through her as a vessel prepared and used by GOD.

She was a woman of tested ability, sound judgment, keen perception, fine and godly character, a sincere friend and devoted worker. She served in numerous positions where she could help people, especially children. Edna exemplified the highest standard of public service in her career. She was modest, but thorough to her task.
