Reverend Edna R. Wisher, daughter of the late James S. and Louise Ingram, was born on April 1, 1941, in Georgetown, Delaware. She departed this life on Wednesday, March 27, 2019, at Bayhealth Hospital.

Edna graduated from William C. Jason High School. She worked as a CNA at Delaware Hospital for the Chronically Ill until she retired.
