Edward F. Williams, was born on Thursday, March 27, 1947, and departed this life on Friday, March 8, 2019.

He graduated from Kennard High School in 1966. After graduation, Edward joined the armed forces and served in the Viet Nam war. After serving his country, Edward found employment at Princeton Turf in Queenstown, Maryland, and was employed at Bramble Construction for 38 years, until his health forced him to retire. Edward loved his trucks and took his career with Bramble seriously. He was knowledgeable about trucks and took the time to share his knowledge with others. His friend, George McLaughlin, known as “Salt” could vouch for that. Edward and George, known as “Salt & Pepper”, were like brothers.

Edward gave his life to Christ. He sang with the Family Circle Choir in Burrisville, Maryland, under the leadership of Pastor Harvey Greer. He donated his time and was very active in various community activities. He was a member of the Highway Coalition and was a substitute bus driver for his sister-in-law, Beverly Wheeler, with whom he had a close relationship.

When Edward’s health began to fail, James “Junior” Griffin, a close friend who was like a brother, was at his side throughout the journey of his illness. James affectionately took on the role of chauffer and supporter. In addition, Edward

had other special cousins who were like siblings; Elmer Wheeler “Buck”, Betty Lou Whyte, Barbara Ann Baker and Joseph Hynson. Ed and Janice Jones, the medical assistant at the cancer center, also developed a strong, sibling bond. She often went beyond her job description to aid Edward during his illness.

Edward was preceded in death by his brother, Joseph Wheeler, II and grandson, Demetrius LaMonte Finney.

Edward leaves to cherish his memory, his mother, Lillian Brown; daughter, Angela Williams Ross of VA; granddaughter, Anthoneisha Ringgold; two grandsons, Joe L. Finney, II, and Edward Finney (Daysha) all of VA; stepsisters, Faye and Emma Brown; aunts, Cecelia Washington (David) and Shirley Newman; uncle, William Jacobs; two nephews, TreVion Wheeler and Joseph Wheeler “LJ”; and a host of cousins, nieces, nephews and friends. His riding partner, “Big John” was truly this man’s best friend and protector.
