



## Eleith Rosetta Barrett

June 30, 1931 - February 24, 2018

Eleith R. Barrett passed away on February 24, 2018, at the age of 86. Eleith was born on Tuesday, June 30th, 1931, in Port Antonio, Portland Jamaica, to the late Steven and Imogene Buchanan. She was a big part of the Vocational Bible School and would always make sure she took care of the children by bringing

them her home baked pastries and drinks.
