Elizabeth Davis, daughter of the late Richard Davis, Sr. and Helen Matthews Davis was born on March 22, 1934 in Keller, Virginia. She departed this life on Friday, February 28, 2014. She was 79 years old.

Elizabeth Davis was raised in Keller, Virginia and received her education through the Accomack County Public Schools. In the early 1960's, she moved to Delaware. Known as Lil by her family and friends, she was a well-known and respected matriarch of the Coolsprings Community and provided daycare services for the majority of the families there.
