Elsie Mae Schoolfield Harmon was born on April 10, 1928 to the late Clarence and Ella Schoolfield in Snow Hill, Maryland. She departed this earthly life on Monday, October 17, 2022 at Tidal Health Peninsula Regional in Salisbury, Maryland surrounded by her loved ones.

Elsie, the youngest of five children, was raised in a loving Christian home and as a child, attended St James Holiness Church and was baptized in the Pocomoke River at an early age.
