She peacefully departed this life on Wednesday, August 28, 2024 at her home with family.

She was educated in the Worcester County School system.

Esther was a dedicated employee at several poultry plants where she became a mother figure to so many people. She was also hairdresser to many. She would have her children clean on Fridays so she could do hair on Saturdays. She had a passion for cooking and had so many requests for her to make her sweet potato pies, rice pudding, bread pudding, tuna casserole and stewed tomatoes, just to name a few. Almost every Sunday she would have some family members come for dinner. She loved reading her Harlequin present books and she would say how many places she had traveled. She loved talking on the phone until she said, "it's time enough now to get off the phone." She loved her children and loved talking about them. She would tell people that she had so many children all over and the color didn't matter. Tonya (Tiny) was her pride and joy.

She had several caregivers in addition to Annette, Curt and Terrie. Cordelia and a young lady "India Thomas" with whom she felt a special bond and appreciated as well as long time friends, Janice Conquest, Cora " Bootsie" and Josephine Spence.

She would come to choir practice with a song or two that she wanted to practice and sing during Sunday morning services or at other times. If some of us on the choir had not heard those songs before, she would patiently teach them to us. And on Sunday mornings, she was always ready and willing to sing her songs. And oh, how she sang to the glory of God!

Esther was also an usher, a member of the United Methodist Women and other church groups. The church would often have throughout the year various special services such as Back Home Day, Men’s Day, Women’s Day, Youth Day and more. Quite often, the church would serve after service free refreshments or a complete sit-down meal for all in attendance. Church volunteers would often begin preparing the refreshments or meals in the church’s kitchen and setting up the dining room the day before these special services. The sponsor of these events could always count on Esther to help plan and serve however or whenever she was needed.

Esther served her church and those in need in the church community faithfully as she also worked outside the home and raised her children to know and love God. Now, she has returned to God, her Maker to rest from her labor in His presence throughout eternity.
