REFLECTIONS OF LIFE

Agnes Louise Horsey, affectionately known as Evangelist Horsey, departed her life on Sunday, November 27, 2022 at Deer's Head Hospital in Salisbury, Maryland.

Agnes was born April 12, 1934 in Westover, Maryland to the late Robert and Inesta Fountain. She attended public school in Somerset County, Maryland and Wilmington, Delaware. Agnes attended the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) in Princess Anne, Maryland and Salisbury State Teacher's College.

Married to the late William Henry Horsey, Sr., together they raised six children, Joann Cottman, Christopher Horsey, William Henry Horsey, Jr. (Jeanette), David Leon Horsey (Jona), Elizabeth Faulcon (Robert) and Jesse James Horsey (deceased) and longtime family member and friend, Mr. Herbert Cottman.

A lifetime member of Samuel Wesley United Methodist Church in Manokin, Maryland, she was lovingly known to everyone as Evangelist Agnes Horsey. While there, she birthed "We Care, We Share Outreach Ministry." She knew it as her "church without walls" and Evangelist Agnes Horsey worked it for thirty-seven (37) years. She ministered at Wicomico Nursing Home, Lakeview Adult Center, Westover Adult Center, Shady Pines, Manokin Manor, Aurora Nursing Home and Deer's Head Hospital, volunteering for more than twenty (20) years

as Chaplain.

Along with being a mother of six, she was a foster parent, an extension agent, which allowed her to go into homes and help parents prepare meals and care for their children, a 4-H Leader, Princess Anne Courthouse employee and she was a Notary Public.

She worked in the Somerset County school system for thirty-six (36) years. During the summer season when school was out, she was a teacher to the migrant children. Behind the scenes, she clothed, fed, care for, groomed, nurtured and loved a lot of children. There is so much more that only God knew about.

Agnes leaves precious memories with: five children, Joann, Christopher, William, Jr. (Jeanette), David (Jona) and Elizabeth Faulcon (Robert); two sisters, Lorraine Fountain and Della Stalling; one sister-law, Edna Boyd and one brother-in law, Haywood Boyd (Dee); her god daughter, Frances Fitchett and five generations of loved ones to carry on her legacy.
