EVELYN FARRARE'S JOURNEY

Evelyn (DeLarge) Farrare, a resident of Vienna, Maryland, passed away peacefully at her home at the age of ninety-five (95), surrounded by her loving family on Tuesday, April 16, 2024. Evelyn was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on February 13, 1929, to the late Daniel and Lelar (Gates) DeLarge.

Evelyn was blessed with seven sisters and three brothers, all of whom preceded her in death. Evelyn attended school in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and married her sweetheart William (Andrew) Farrare on December 21, 1943, (who also preceded her in death).

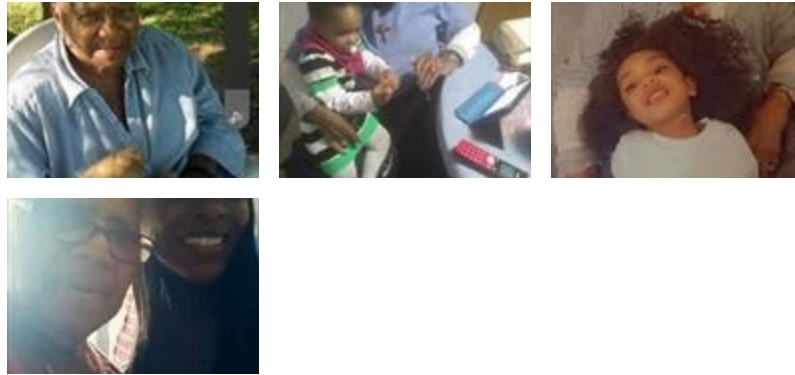
