Florzell Daniels was born in Blakely, Georgia on Saturday, March 1, 1930 to the late Pleas and Daisey Lee Daniels. He was the only son, and the eldest of three. Florzell departed this life on Thursday, April 12, 2018 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital in Seaford, Delaware.

He received his education at Washington High School in Blakely, Georgia. After leaving home, he served in the United States Air Force from 1947 to 1949. He later found his passion for horses, and started professionally grooming horses in 1958; working until his illness in 2015. A legend in the harness-racing industry, affectionately known as Georgia Boy, who touched the lives of many with his humble spirit and infectious smile. He worked at various racetracks including Harrington Raceway, Dover Downs, Freehold, Chester, Meadowlands, Ocean Downs, Colonial Downs and Rosecroft. At the vibrant age of 83, he proudly received the honor of Groom of the Year in 2012. He thoroughly enjoyed reading the newspaper, watching sports, laughing, joking, having fun and doting on his family.

With the guidance of his son, Ardell, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior.

Florzell is preceded in death by his loving parents, Pleas and Daisy Lee Daniels; one sister, Onita Beale and one daughter, Jeannette Daniels. He

leaves to cherish his memory, his loving wife of 46 years, Frances C.
