September 25, 1947 - January 6, 2026

Pastor Floyd Joseph Richo, beloved son of the late Phalos Richo and Eugenia Richo, was born

September 25, 1947 in New York, New York.

He was educated in the Worcester County Public School System. He graduated from Worcester

High School in Newark, Maryland in 1965 and then enlisted in the United States Army that same year.

For seventeen (17) years, Pastor Richo worked at the Campbell Soup Company in Pocomoke,

Maryland. Once it closed its doors for good, he worked as an Insurance Agent for thirty-three

(33) years, a job that he loved.

Pastor Floyd Richo was an Ordained Deacon under the leadership of Pastor James Marshall. He

later became an Ordained Minister under the leadership of Pastor Greta Belote. For many years,

he was preaching, singing and serving the Lord up and down the Eastern Shore. In April 2021,

he was installed as Pastor of Mount Sinai Baptist Church. He was one of the original members of

the Soul Searchers gospel groups formed at Mount Sinai. He was also the

President of the Male

Chorus. His motto was found in Psalm 45:1...My pen is a pen of a ready writer. He always carried

his favorite pen and made sure you handed it back to him.

In his earlier years he loved to jog and take long distance rides in his car until he injured his

ankle. He loved listening to Gospel music, watching basketball (a favorite pastime) and he also

loved people, having a good laugh, being in church and fellowshiping with the saints.

Pastor Richo leaves to cherish precious memories: his wife of forty-seven (47) years Dorothy

Richo; mother-in-law, Willie Mae Purnell; four sons, Craig (Sharon) Collins of Salisbury,
