Frances Ann Brooks Wheeler, or Sis, as she was affectionately known, was born on December 18, 1936, to the late Charles W. Brooks, Jr. and Dorothy Baynard Brooks. She departed this life peacefully, on July 21, 2021, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, Maryland.
