Freddie joined the United States Army in 1963 and served four years. Upon his return, he matriculated at Prince Georges Community College.

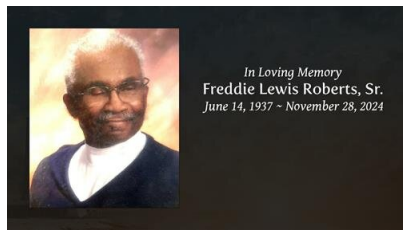

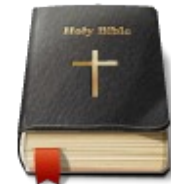
