Obituary

Sweetie loved a good laugh and would find humor in many situations. It was not unusual to hear her laughing at something that she found amusing. She enjoyed talking on the telephone to family, especially Cousin Dolly Rhodes, and friends. As she talked on the phone, you knew that she was tickled about something because you would hear that laugh. Listening to music, especially

gospel music, was something that she also enjoyed. In her later years, she attended and became a member of Hurlock United Methodist Church.

Sweetie is survived by her children – one daughter, Sandra Sampson Redmon and three sons, Rayfield Sampson, Gregory Sampson, and Kevin “Algie” Sampson; as well as her grandson, Kevin Sampson, whom she raised.
