George Lynwood Burnette, a resident of Princess Anne, Maryland, was born on January 15, 1942 in Baltimore, Maryland and was the youngest son of the late William Omar Burnette, Sr. and Henrietta Zella Bivens Burnette. He departed this life at the age of eighty-one (81) on Friday, March 3, 2023 at home surrounded by his family.

“Baby George” as he was affectionately called by his family, was given that nickname because he was living with his grandfather, George Burnette, who had the same name.

He was reared in a Christian home by his late “Poppa” George and his grandmother, Estina Burnette. At an early age, his Christian training was received at John Wesley Methodist Church in Deal Island, Maryland. He attended and graduated from the schools in Somerset County, Maryland.
