Gladys Mildred Matthews Wright, the youngest daughter of the late Gladys Laws Matthews and the late Herbert Matthews, was born in Concord, Delaware on Thursday, June 17, 1920.

She departed this life at the age of 94 at the Genesis Nursing Home Unit 2 in Seaford, Delaware on Friday, September 5, 2014.

Her elementary education was received at Concord School #216 in Concord, DE. Her high school education began at Frederick Douglass School in Seaford, Delaware.

Mildred accepted Christ at an early age at Mt. Calvary A.M.E. Church in Concord, DE and continued to grow in grace as the years passed. She felt keenly the calling of the Lord to the ministry, which she later accepted. This led her to reach out to other areas. She joined Mt. Sinai Holy Church and was an ordained Evangelist.

On March 13, 1941, she met and married James Michael Wright, better known as "Mike", as he was called by all. Six weeks after marriage, Mike was inducted into the army. She then decided to go into training to be a nurse. She worked at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury and Genesis Nursing Home in Seaford for many years before retiring in 1985.

She never forgot her home church, Mt. Calvary A.M.E. Church in Concord, DE, where she started. She will be remembered for her patience, concern and her love for Christ. When trials and heartaches came, she would say, "they only make us strong because God is still in control." Her Christian faith and

hope never failed even through her illness.
