### Obituary

Goldsboro Milbourne, affectionately known as Golby and Pop, made his heavenly transition on March 3, 2018 at his home in Laurel, Delaware.

Goldsboro, son of the late Theodore Milbourne and Priscilla Waters Milbourne was born on September 13, 1925 in Snow Hill, MD.

Amanda Ellen Shockley Milbourne preceded him in death in 1997.
