Grannette's Journey

Grannette Yvette (Salter) Jones was born on February 27, 1981 to Grant Salter III and the late Etzel Schrell Wiggins at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury, Maryland. Grannette unexpectedly passed away on January 12, 2025 at the age of forty-three (43).

Grannette attended school in the Wicomico County Public School system and graduated from James M. Bennett Senior High in 1999. After high school, she obtained a Nursing Assistant certification. She accepted positions of employment at the Berlin Nursing and Rehabilitation Center and later at Genesis Nursing Center in Salisbury, Maryland. She was also continuing her education at Wor-Wic Community College.

Grannette was a fun-loving lady and every time she was in the presence of others, she would always brandish the biggest and prettiest smile to signify that she was glad to see them. She was a praying lady and she knew the Lord. She willingly gave her life to Christ and was baptized on April 23, 1994 at St. Matthews First Baptist Church in Laurel, Delaware under the hand and seal of The Reverend Nathan Reed-McCoy, Sr. She joined Tyree A.M. E. Church in Berlin, Maryland on November 24, 1996 under the leadership of Reverend Robert N. Brown, Jr. rededicating her life to Christ in June 2001.
