Herb's Life Story

Herbert Lee Bradley, Sr. was born October 5, 1944, to the late Ollen and Martha (Polk) Bradley in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He received his wings on August 15, 2019.

Herb met Joyce Bland, and they were married January 20, 1985. They lived in Philadelphia, relocating to Georgia and finally made Dover, Delaware, their home. Herb, with the help of Joyce continued to help raise four children from previous relationships. Herb joined the United States Army in 1965, and served until his Honorable discharge in 1968. He then became a Corrections Officer at the State Correctional Institution at Graterford, Perkiomen Township, Pennsylvania; where he retired after thirty years.

Herb was raised to the sublime degree of a Master Mason in Corinthians Lodge No. 114, Philadelphia, PA on January 10, 1975. He became Worshipful Master of Corinthian Lodge #114 in 1986. Herb was also part of The Holy Royal Arch Chapter (Red House) Bethel Chapter No. 39, De Molay Consistory No. 1 and Ancient Egypt Arabic Order Noble Mystic Shrine (A.E.A.O.N.M.S) North and South America Incorporated, Pyramid Temple No. 1. mission to handle all, above and beyond his abilities and he stood out making a monumental statement.

He accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age. After moving to Delaware, he joined Star Hill A.M.E. Church under the leadership of Reverend Rita Mishoe Paige, Pastor. As a member for seven years, Herb served faithfully with the soup kitchen, as a trustee, a member of the male choir, Men's ministry, the culinary committee and a good steward. Brother Bradley rose to the position of Vice-Chair of the Steward Board after the passing of Brother Nelson Driggus. He served faithfully until his health no longer allowed him to perform the task. Herb really loved his Star Hill church family and truly appreciated the outpouring of love and support during his illness. On August 1, 2019, Herb joined New Beginnings Community A.M.E. Church in Frederica, Delaware, continuing under the leadership of his previous pastor.

Herb was preceded in death by his daughter Vernetta and his grandson, Robert. He leaves to cherish his precious memories, his wife, Joyce; children, Kathryn, Herbert Jr., and William (Janis); grandchildren, Joseph, Herbert III, Cornelius, Shawna, Jeremiah, Thea, Caleb, Taylor and Payton; godsons, Bernard Pratt and Hugh I.
