He was educated in the Somerset County School system. As a life-long member of the John Wesley Methodist Church. Hursel served faithfully as the church treasure and as a member of the Board of Trustees.

Hursel loved life and was committed to his family and friends. His accomplishments and membership included service to the VFW, the American Legion, and he also served as treasurer of the Somerset County School Bus Association. These accomplishments were in addition to his serving as a Police Officer for 20+ years at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore, 40+ years as a school bus contractor for Somerset County and he was a dedicated member of the U.S. Navy who served in World War II.
