Jeff loved to chew on some twizzlers, especially the red ones. Although Jeff's favorite color was red, he enjoyed wearing bright and lovely colors. He barely wore black and white.

Jeff was very active in the church. He was a Sunday school teacher where he taught the youth about God and the Bible. Jeff was a warrior for Christ. He would evangelize wherever he went; at the basketball park, at his job and at his school. During his stay at the hospital whomever stepped a foot in his room he was willing to share the Gospel with that person. Jeff was a spiritual father to the youth of his community. No matter what time it was he was willing to help or pray with his friends. Jeff was a spiritual advisor to the youth in the community and devoted many hours teaching them about the Word of God.
