Jermaine's love for Christ began at his very first church home, Bibleway Temple COGIC. He completed his early education in the Capital School District, graduating from Dover High School in 1996. After high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and completed several deployments in the Middle East as a member of a Special Forces Team, where he was ultimately awarded the Purple Heart in recognition of his courageous and heroic actions during battle. Upon completion of his military service, he was honorably discharged at the rank of Specialist.
