Obituary

Jerry Norman Copes, Sr., formerly of Horntown, Virginia, was a resident of Salisbury, Maryland. He peacefully departed this earthly life on Friday, April 15, 2022 at Tidal Health Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury, Maryland.

Born on June 10, 1952, he was the son of the late George Copes and Holland Stansbury (Lawrence Stansbury). Jerry was a graduate of Stephen Decatur High School in Berlin, Maryland.

The beloved husband of Edna Copes, they were joined in holy matrimony on June 28, 1996. They enjoyed a loving union of twenty-six (26) years.

Jerry entered military service on the 25th day of January 1974. He served in the United States Army 22nd Infantry as a mechanic until his honorable discharge on the 5th day of November 1976.
