He attended Cambridge public schools and graduated from Mace's Lane High School in 1958. Shortly afterwards, he joined Gloria Richardson and the Freedom Riders in the Civil Rights Movement. In 1969, he joined the army until 1970. He moved to Philadelphia and joined the police force, serving from 1970 to 1974. In 1975, he moved back to Cambridge where he would stay. He is survived by a son, Johnnie Weeks, Jr.; two special friends, Ms. Bynito and Sherry Jackson; numerous cousins and even more numerous friends. He was preceded in death by his parents, Raymond Holland and Mildred Weeks; a brother, Charles Allen of NY and a daughter, Mildred Neal-Cephas.
