Celebrating the Life of DEACON JOSEPH EDWARD JONES

Deacon Joseph Edward Jones, affectionately known to many as “Tommy”, at the age of ninety-one (91), went to take his heavenly journey on April 28, 2025, at home in Fruitland, Maryland with loved ones at his bedside. He was born on May 4, 1933, in Scotland Neck, North Carolina to the late Geneva Jones.
