Kate Elliott was born in Suffolk, Virginia, on Tuesday, March 22, 1927, to the late Rena Elliott.

At a young age, Kate and her family migrated to Berlin, Maryland. Kate called Berlin, home, until 1961. From Berlin, she relocated to Frankford, Delaware, where she spent many years before becoming a resident of the Shady Grove Retirement Community in Selbyville, Delaware. She remained at Shady Grove until December of 2018. On December 2, 2018, she was admitted to the Cadia Renaissance Healthcare facility in Millsboro, where she resided for the next two and a half years.
